

Chardonnay for an outstanding price. The deal was 'no mentioning the name' hence the anonymous label. The winemaker is a bit of a star too – IWSC Winemaker of the Year in 2009, 2011 and 2012. Enjoy its ripe peach and nectarine flavours, zesty freshness and long, mouthwatering finish.
