Variety:	Blend of Riesling and Müller-Thurgau
Origin:	Niersteiner Gutes Domtal, Rheinhessen. Rheinhessen, the largest German wine-growing area has a more than thousand-year-old tradition of wine-growing. For this blend we selected grapes from the district Niersteiner Gutes Domtal, which surrounds the famous town of Nierstein on Rhine. Soil mainly consists of sandy loam. The climate is mild with lots of sun hours and sufficient rainfall.
Vintage Note:	After a mild winter and a cold spring followed by a very humid summer we experienced a beautifully warm late summer and dry autumn with perfect harvesting conditions. 2016 vintage turned out to produce fruit driven, very accessible wines with excellent structure and ripeness.
Winemaking:	This Qualitätswein from the Rheinhessen region was fermented temperature controlled, stored in stainless steel and bottled cold sterile.
Wine Analysis:	Alc. 8.5 % vol. Residual Sugar 42.0 g/l Acidity 6.5 g/l
Winemakers Tasting Note:	An easy drinking white wine with good fruit aromas, light bodied with a slightly sweet aftertaste.
Food Matches:	A wine for every day. It is the perfect accompaniment to any light meal, or makes a great drink on its own. Serve well chilled.
