> Rheinhessen, the largest German winegrowing area has a more than thousandyear-old tradition of wine-growing. For this blend we selected grapes from the district Niersteiner Gutes Domtal, which surrounds the famous town of Nierstein on Rhine.

> Soil mainly consists of sandy loam. The climate is mild with lots of sun hours and

sufficient rainfall.

Vintage Note: After a mild winter and a cold spring

followed by a very humid summer we experienced a beautifully warm late summer and dry autumn with perfect harvesting conditions. 2016 vintage turned out to produce fruit driven, very accessible wines

with excellent structure and ripeness.
