WINEMAKING

Type of fermentation: The wine underwent a process of assemblage to bring out its full qualities; 50% was fermented in stainless steel tanks whereas the rest was barrel-fermented and aged for 8 months.

Number of days of fermentation: 2 weeks

Fermentation temperature: 14°C in stainless steel and 16°C in oak

Ageing: 8 months barrel aging (50% new oak, combination of

TASTING NOTES

The wine has a brilliant gold color. Fragrant and exquisitely fine floral (verbena) and fruit (pineapple, mango) aroma with a vegetative note (fennel). The palate is silky, intense, very luscious, culminating in a smoky, elegant finish.

SERVING SUGGESTIONS

A wonderful match with fine seafood and fish as well as certain types of fowl. Serve at 8–10°C.

Soil

Very deep red alkaline soils with a high water holding capacity and very high levels of active limestone. Ypresian/Lutetian clay formations (Lower-Middle Eocene period).

Precipitation and temperatures were normal in 2015, but the vegetative cycle was dry, and the grape-ripening period saw a cold spell.
